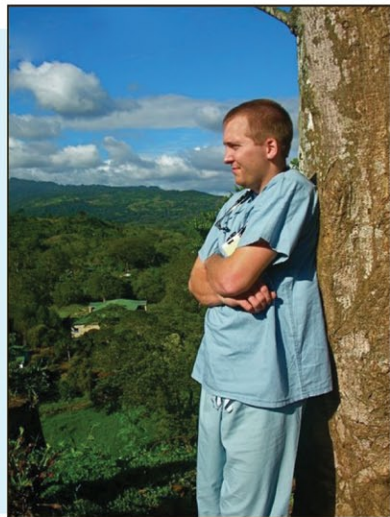

~ Here is the problem ~

In 2007 only *2%* of surveyed medical students from leading U.S. medical schools planned careers in general internal medicine

35% of physicians nationwide are over 55 and will retire in the next 5 to 10 years



The population age 85 and over, who are most likely to require chronic care services for multiple conditions, will increase *50%* from 2000 to 2010

The demand for general internists will increase from 106,000 in 2000 to nearly 200,000 in 2020, an increase of *53%*
